Eligibility & Juror

- The Under 40 show is open to artists under the age of 40 who live within a 50-mile radius of Woodstock who can hand deliver and pick up accepted works of art.
- Artists are invited to submit works in all media, any subject for this juried exhibition.
- Juror: Greg Slick, an artist and independent curator who deals with themes ranging from everyday observations of human nature to intellectual issues of global and historical significance. Slick works in photography, video and painting. A recent curatorial project was *The Illustrious Mr. X: Museum Collection as Character Study* which he co-curated with Karlos Carcamo at the Samuel Dorsky Museum of Art, SUNY New Paltz, New Paltz, NY.

Awards

The Harriet Livathinos/Rei Fraas Juror's Choice Award (\$100).

All artists selected by the juror for this exhibition will receive one year's free membership to WAAM (a \$135 value).

Media & Size Limitations

All media are accepted. Works must not exceed 75 lbs. and 48" x 48" x 48" (including frame). The base of 3-D work should be no greater than 24" x 24" or artists must supply their own pedestal. All work must be in good condition and ready to hang or install. Any special installation needs (ie. computer equipment) must be supplied by artist for the duration of the show and should be noted in submission. The WAAM reserves the right to reject works that do not comply with these guidelines or are otherwise found to be unsuitable for display or inconsistent with submission.

To Enter

No Entry Fee required.

Submit up to 12 digital images on a CD (Mac or PC compatible). Digital images should be jpegs sized 4" x 5" at 300 dpi (1200 pixels x 1500 pixels). All images must be identified with artist's last name, first name, and number (ie. SmithJane1) that correspond to a separate list to be provided by artist. CDs should be clearly marked with artist's full name and phone number. WAAM may reject submissions if the quality of jpegs is deemed inadequate. Artists must include a SASE for return of CDs if desired.

Sales & Insurance

The WAAM will encourage sales and takes a 40% commission, however works of art need not be for sale. Artists should fill in retail price (including commission) or insurance value on entry form. The WAAM provides insurance for works of art while on the premises.

Delivery & Pickup

All work must be delivered and picked up in person. Shipped work cannot be accepted and will be rejected. No exceptions will be made. All work must arrive ready for hanging and installation.

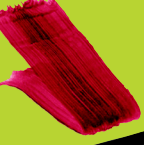
