

### Woodstock Regional Juried Exhibition

Artists are invited to submit works in all media and of all subjects for this exhibition. The exhibition is open to artists from Connecticut, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, and Vermont who can hand deliver and pick up accepted works of art.

### Juror: Patricia Phagan

Patricia Phagan is the Philip and Lynn Straus Curator of Prints and Drawings at the Frances Lehman Loeb Art Center (formerly the Vassar College Art Gallery) at Vassar College in Poughkeepsie, New York. In 2000, the same year she came to Vassar, she received her Ph.D. in art history from the City University of New York with a dissertation on American political cartoons. From 1987 to 1999 she was the curator of prints and drawings at the Georgia Museum of Art at the University of Georgia in Athens. She is a member of Print Council of America, a recipient of a Luce Dissertation Fellowship in American Art, and editor and author of numerous exhibition catalogues, including *Adriaen van Ostade: Etchings of Peasant Life in Holland's Golden Age*; *The American Scene and the South: Paintings and Works on Paper, 1930 – 1946*; *Hudson River School Drawings from Dia Art Foundation*; and *Made in Woodstock: Printmaking from 1903 to 1945*. She has organized dozens of exhibitions, ranging from old masters to contemporary.

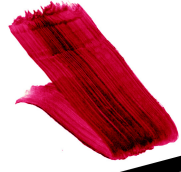

## Eligibility & Juror

- Artists are invited to submit works in all media and of all subjects for this regional juried exhibition.
- The exhibition is open to artists from Connecticut, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, and Vermont, who can hand deliver and pick up accepted works of art.
- The juror is Patricia Phagan, Straus Curator or Prints and Drawings at the Frances Lehman Loeb Art Center, Vassar College. (see other page for juror bio).

## Awards

## Media & Size Limitations

All media is accepted. Works must not exceed 75 lbs. and 48" x 48" x 48" (including frame). The base of 3-D work should be no greater than 24" x 24" or artists must supply their own pedestal. All work must be in good condition and ready to hang or install. Any special installation needs (ie. computer equipment) must be supplied by artist for the duration of the show and should be noted in submission. The WAAM reserves the right to reject works that do not comply with these

guidelines or are otherwise found to be unsuitable for display or inconsistent with submission.

## To Enter

Submit digital images by email or on a CD (PC compatible). 35 mm slides in a plastic sleeve are also acceptable. **To submit by email, follow guidelines at [www.woodstockart.org](http://www.woodstockart.org).** Digital images on CD should be jpeg with a resolution of 200 dpi and no more than 1000 pixels in any dimension. All images must be identified with artist last name, first name, and corresponding number (ie. SmithJane1.jpg) that corresponds to a separate list. CDs should be clearly marked with artist's full name and phone number. WAAM may reject submissions if the quality of slides or jpegs is deemed inadequate. **Artists must include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of CDs or slides.**

## Sales & Insurance

The WAAM will encourage sales and takes a 40% commission, however works of art need not be for sale. Artists should check off retail price (including commission) or insurance value on entry form and provide

amount. The WAAM provides insurance for works of art while on the premises.

## Delivery & Pickup

All work must be delivered and picked up in person. Shipped work cannot be accepted and will be rejected. No exceptions will be made. All work must arrive ready for hanging and installation.

## Submission Fees

First two images: \$35 for non-members, \$15 for WAAM members. \$5 for each additional entry. Fees are non-refundable. Fees may be paid by check or credit card.
