Woodstock, NY – The Woodstock Artists Association & Museum is pleased to announce *Extraordinary Birds*, a solo show by photographer Stephen Green-Armytage. This exhibition will be on view in the Solo Gallery from September 24 through November 7, with an opening reception on Saturday, September 25 from 4-6pm. Mr. Green-Armytage was chosen for a solo exhibition by juror Kristen Dodge, the owner and director of September Gallery in Hudson, NY.

This presentation will feature a selection of color photographs of chickens, pheasants, and pigeons, which are by turns interesting, beautiful, striking, charming, and imbued with humor. Each photograph captures a fragment of time that gives life to a small, fleeting moment and makes the subject—as opposed to the photographer—the hero of the frame. Textures, colors, and patterns emerge in striking detail, as everyday birds are rendered anything but ordinary.

About the Artist

Stephen Green-Armytage has had a long career as a freelance professional photographer, working with many publications including *Sports Illustrated*, *Fortune*, and *LIFE*. He has published a number of successful books of

photography including *Extraordinary Chickens*, *Extraordinary Pigs* and *Extraordinary Leaves*. He is originally from the UK and currently lives and works in Woodstock and New York City. stephengreenarmytage.com
